CALL FOR POSTERS

In preparation for the International Conference **MONETE FRAZIONATE. ASPETTI ECONOMICI, QUESTIONI CRONOLOGICHE, QUADRI REGIONALI** (Milan, 16th-17th September 2019) the Organizing Committee invites numismatists, archaeologists, university lecturers, researchers, scholars, and staff of Superintendencies and Scientific Research Institutes and other bodies to submit poster proposals related to the theme of this event.

The Conference is focussed on a particular category of coins, those that were deliberately cut into two or more portions while in circulation, so as to create two or more coins, in periods of insufficient supply by mints of smaller value coins. The phenomenon has been mainly studied for the late Roman Republic and the early Empire, but it is also widespread in other cultural areas and date ranges.

There is a need to address the question of coin-cutting with up-to-date analytical methods, above all on the basis of the detailed documentation produced by the most recent stratigraphic archaeological excavations, which alone can provide reliable chronological indications. It also seems advisable to broaden the scope of the investigation as much as possible, both with regard to date (for example: late Roman, Byzantine, medieval and modern periods) and

geographically speaking, so as to define regional frameworks which can then be assembled to obtain an overall picture, in which there are differences and similarities between zones.

The Proceedings of the Conference - including the texts of the posters presented - will be published in the second issue (2020) of the scientific journal "Dialoghi di numismatica. Protagonisti, prospettive, ricerche", published by the University of Salerno.

Posters might report results that have emerged from completed or ongoing research projects, data from unpublished stratigraphic surveys, or recent numismatic discoveries.

Poster proposals (see *Appendix A*) must be sent to the e-mail address monetafrazionata.unicatt2019@gmail.com not after **April 30th 2019**, and must include: title, author(s) name(s) and institution(s), together with a brief abstract (maximum 500 words and two illustrations with captions) and be written in one of the following languages: Italian, English, French, Spanish or German.

The Scientific Committee will evaluate the proposals received on the basis of quality, analytical approach, originality and degree of relevance to the themes of the Conference, and – if the number of requests should be higher than can be accommodated – order of arrival. The outcome will be communicated to all interested parties by **May 30th 2019**. Authors of posters that are accepted must register for the Conference and pay the registration fee of **40 euro**, by bank transfer, **no later than June 30th 2019** to the Dipartimento di Scienze del Patrimonio Culturale dell'Università degli Studi di Salerno, current account IBAN IT71D0200876210000102457929 – BIC CODE UNCRITM1NH1, UniCredit Banca; motive: **DNum moneta frazionata, iscrizione convegno name and surname, DISPAC**. The registration fee includes: participation in the meetings and coffee breaks, the meeting bag and folder, and a certificate of participation. Posters will be displayed continuously during the meeting. A print of the abstracts will be given to all registered participants. For each poster, the presence of a presenter (the author or one of the co-authors, excluding those who already appear as speakers) must be guaranteed.

The **Società Numismatica Italiana - Onlus** has promoted an award for the best poster presented during the Conference. The prize consists of a subvention of € 200.00, accompanied by a medal celebrating the 125th anniversary of the founding of the "Società Numismatica Italiana" (see below).

APPENDIX B

POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

Each author is responsible for the preparation and printing of his/her poster. Poster authors are invited to follow the criteria and suggestions listed below, in order that the poster will clearly legible from a distance of up to 2-3 metres.

Dimensions: the poster must be prepared in format 70 x 100 cm.

Orientation: the poster must be orientated vertically.

Font types: it is advisable to use a clearly legible font (for example Times New Roman or Arial) of a size that may be read easily.

Heading: the heading of the poster must contain the easily legible title (minimum 36 points), below which must be indicated the forename(s) and surname(s) of the author(s) and the associated institution(s), project and website names where relevant, and e-mail address(es).

Text: the character size used for the text should be about 24 points.

Illustrations: it is advisable to keep a reasonable balance between the space used for illustrations and that occupied by the text of the poster. Photographs should be clear with a resolution not less than 300 dpi.

Presentation: authors may prepare A4 prints of the poster, in colour or black and white, to distribute to interested parties.

The "Società Numismatica Italiana - Onlus" promotes an award for the best poster presented during the Conference *Monete frazionate. Aspetti economici, questioni cronologiche, quadri regionali*, which will take place in Milan at the Catholic University of the Sacred Heart, on 16 and 17 September 2019.

The prize consists of a subvention of € 200.00, accompanied by a medal celebrating the 125th anniversary of the founding of the "Società Numismatica Italiana".

The Selection Committee will be composed of the President of the "Società Numismatica Italiana" (or a deputy of him) and the members of the Scientific Committee of the Conference. The choice of the winner will be made at the indisputable discretion of the Commission.

The best poster will be selected on the basis of the following criteria: high-quality level and originality of the research; development of the contents; skill in presenting the subject also in terms of graphic layout.

The prize must be personally received by the winner only on the day of the ceremony. Otherwise, it will be invalidated. In the case of *ex aequo*, the younger author will be awarded.
